THE TAJ

After two and a half years of planning and a few missed opening dates along the way, we are pleased to announce that the Taj is finally open. The soft opening was this past weekend and it is now open to the public.

The Taj, at 807 East Market Street, is in an 1840's historic building owned by long time NBA Board Member, Mike Maloney. The bar's fleur de lis logo is adorned with the well-recognized fedora that is Mike's signature apparel accessory.

Taj is a modern interpretation of a classic saloon with a unique interior design featuring reclaimed wood wainscoting, walls featuring reclaimed whiskey ricks and bar seating using antique elevator operator seats. Antique shutters and wooden bourbon logos cover the ceiling. There is custom iron work throughout and an etched glass transom featuring popular Louisville attractions and events.

The bar has 12 draught taps featuring craft beers and a long list of bottle and canned beers and they plan to join the Urban Bourbon Trail featuring over 100 bourbon brands.

In the very near future, lunch, small plates, snacks and a late night menu will be added and an outdoor beer and bourbon garden and patio is under construction.

The hours of operation are Monday-Friday 4:00 p.m.-4:00 a.m., Saturday and Sunday 12:00 p.m.-4:00 a.m.

The Taj is available for private events, parties and business gatherings. The Taj is owned and operated by Todd Moore with business manager Ken Blackthorn.

The NBA welcomes the Taj and encourages everyone to check it out. It was worth the wait! ▪

IMPOSSIBLE PLACES AT GARNER NARRATIVE

Please join garner narrative and welcome Keith Stone for his third solo show with the gallery: Impossible Places.

The show opens Friday June 3rd, with a reception from 6:00 -9:00 p.m. concurrent with the First Friday Gallery Hop, and runs through July 29th.

Stone writes:

You know I hate statements.

I've always found that the best stories are about the pairings of ideas, people, objects, things and situations that do not seem to go together—impossible fits. It is within those collisions and the spaces that they create that I look for ways to tell stories graphically. Maybe they portray the impossible. Or maybe we are not as open to the possibilities as we were when we were children. Think of an impossible place. Go there. I have.

In the past Stone has tackled current issues such as drone surveillance, self-construction in the age of social media, and contemporary art itself when recontextualized as a luxury good. Impossible Places enters Stone's personal terrain, a landscape of surreal and revealing juxtapositions.

Stone developed his political, aesthetic and intellectual sensibilities in both architecture and journalism (M.Arch., U of KY.; B.S. Journalism Boston University). He paints his landscapes in architectural rendering programs, with occasional touches of digital photography. Stone's work has been collected by 21C Museum Hotels and the University of KY.

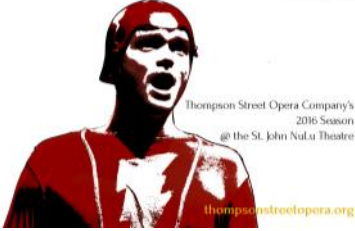
VIA STUDIO LAUNCHES NEW BRAND IDENTITY FOR WATERFRONT PARK

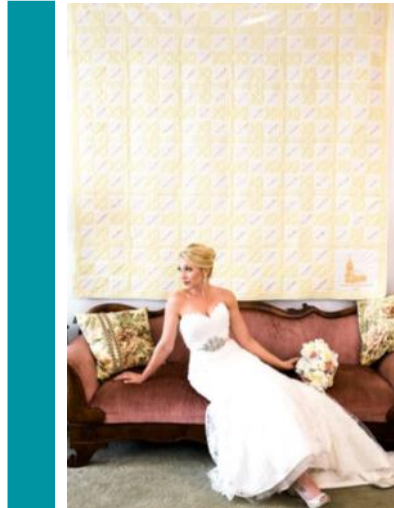
